With beginnings in 1860, Julia Farr established the first Anglican charitable organisation, The Orphan Home. Over time, it became obvious that there was a need for care accommodation to support older people, and during the 1940s was the start of offering aged care services. Today, known as Anglicare SA, they support more than 50,000 South Australians through 1800 hard-working staff, 300 dedicated volunteers and a diverse portfolio of social service programs.

A member of CCI since 2005, Anglicare SA utilise 9 of the contracts offered across food, consumables and services categories. Cristina said: "It has been challenging managing the increasing cost base experienced post-Covid. Being a member of CCI has facilitated us to be able to access the best value service propositions available and reduced our risk."
